Forever Remembered: Memorial plaque dedicated to three children tragically lost in the Mississippi River



On Friday, March 1<sup>st</sup>, family and loved ones of Brandy (14) and Ally Berry Wilson (8) and Kevin Poole Jr. (15) joined the Algiers Development District (ADD) Algiers Development Corporation (ADC) and Krewe of NOMTOC to unveil a new plaque in tribute of the three lives tragically lost while playing near the Mississippi River almost two years ago.



"We hope and pray that this permanent memorial honoring these young children offers some small comfort to the families," said Chairman Mark Major, Algiers

Development District. "Brandy, Ally and Kevin will always be remembered, and future generations will view this plaque as a testament to the preciousness of their lives and their profound impact on our community." The families want the marker to serve as a warning about the dangers of the Mississippi River and expressed gratitude for the support from the community.

"I just want to say, 'thank you' to the Krewe of NOMTOC and everyone else who participated in making this happen," said Octavia Wilson, the girls' mother. "I appreciate y'all."

The memorial plaque, donated by ADD, ADC and Krewe of NOMTOC, is located on the levee at Socrates Street and Brooklyn Avenue near where the incident occurred in Algiers.
